

ORDINANCE No. 188246

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for construction of the Woodlawn-King Streets Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10331 for \$4,700,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Approximately 16,200 feet of combined sewer pipe in the Woodlawn-King neighborhood are in deteriorated condition and need to be replaced or rehabilitated.
2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for replacing or rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe, including sewer manholes and service laterals.
3. The estimated cost is \$4,700,000. The level of confidence in this estimate is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2017-FY2021 CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10331.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.




