Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the construction of the Middle Hillsdale Rainfall Derived Inflow and Infiltration Pilot Project Laterals, Project No. E10617 for an estimated cost of \$3,400,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In 2012, Council adopted Resolution 36977, recognizing the negative impacts of Rainfall Derived Infiltration and Inflow (RDII), and endorsing implementation of RDII pilot projects.
- 2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for the pilot project to rehabilitate the deteriorated service laterals from the sewer mainline to the house connection to mitigate RDII.
- 3. Environmental Services requires the furnishing of labor and materials to construct this project.
- 4. The estimated cost is \$3,400,000. The level of confidence in this estimate is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2017-FY2021 CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10617.C60, and the future years requested sewer system operating fund budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the a. lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer b. System Operating Fund Budget.
