Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of the proposed legislation is to vacate any interest the public may have in the Hawthorne Bridge west approach ramp as depicted on the attached Exhibit A of the Resolution, and incorporated by reference, to allow for construction of the new Multnomah County Courthouse, slated to begin construction in 2017.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Financial impacts will be minimal, such as staff costs for processing and recording fees and will not require any budget changes. The expenses are occurring in 2016/17 FY and will be charged to SAP Cost Object 9TR000002352.

This legislation does not affect staffing levels nor result in a new or modified financial obligation or benefit now or in the future.

If City Council does not approve the resolution, the County's Vacation Resolution will not be in compliance with State law thereby creating a cloud on Multnomah County's title to the property.

Community impacts and community involvement:

The undeveloped area will become revitalized due to the construction of the new courthouse. No opposition to the vacation request is expected.

Multnomah County has a dedicated web page for the new courthouse on its website that includes reports, FAQ's, photos, and links to news articles. The County also held an open house for the public on April 21, 2016 as well as met with many government officials during the negotiations for the Courthouse project.
