TO THE COUNCIL:

On July 20, 2016, Council approved Ordinance Number 187902 for Procurement Services to competitively solicit the Lents Park Improvement Project in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00000489 on behalf of the Bureau of Portland Parks and Recreation (PP&R), with a project construction estimate of \$907,128.00. PP&R rated the project estimate confidence level as Medium.

Bids were opened on January 5, 2017, and three (3) bids were received. The low bid from Raimore Construction, LLC. was responsive to the solicitation requirements, thus it is recommended that Raimore Construction's bid be accepted at the unit prices quoted for a total bid amount of \$843,821.00.

PP&R along with Procurement Services, identified an aspirational goal for D/M/W/ESB subcontractor and supplier utilization at 20% of the hard construction costs for the project.

Raimore Construction acting as the prime contractor identified the following areas as opportunities for subcontracting: playground installation, surveying, disposal, landscaping, asphalt paving, striping and fabricated handrail. There is \$85,600.00 (10.1%) D/M/W/ESB utilization identified on this project. DBE subcontractor/supplier participation represents 1.4% of the total bid amount and ESB subcontractor/supplier participation represents 8.7% apportioned as follows:

DBE - Survey at \$7,000

DBE - Disposal at \$5,000

ESB - Playground Installation at \$73,600

Raimore Construction as the prime contractor will be self-performing demolition (saw-Cutting), excavation, and concrete for a total of \$635,339.04. Raimore Construction, LLC. is located in Portland, OR, and is a State Certified DBE/MBE contractor. D/M/W/ESB participation on this project is at 85.4% including work performed by the prime. Raimore Construction has a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration, EEO Certification, and are in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available for this project under Owner Cost Center P30004.

It is recommended that a Performance Bond and Payment Bond each at 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the contractor. Further, it is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the contractor before final payment is released.
