

# ORDINANCE No. 188250

\*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University for \$15,000 to research and track naturally occurring affordable housing as part of the Southwest Corridor Equitable Housing Strategy (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Council directed the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability to develop an Equitable Housing Strategy for the Southwest corridor in anticipation of future light rail transit improvements.
2. \$15,000 will be paid to Portland State University (PSU), under the direction of Lisa K. Bates, Ph.D., to carry out naturally occurring affordable housing in the southwest corridor and the impacts future light rail transit improvements may have on this housing. Funds are available in the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability FY 2015-16 Revised Budget, Grant ID PN000060, cost object PN00600001.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental grant agreement with Portland State University in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the intergovernmental agreement chargeable to the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, Cost Object PN00600001 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- c. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is hereby authorized to sign amendments for continuing data management, reporting and funding in future fiscal years if appropriations are approved by City Council.
- d. The City Council waives the competitive application process required in FIN 2.04 – Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to forward funds for services to continue work that benefits the City. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


