Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

To appoint the Mayor's designee to the FPDR Board of Trustees. On June 14, 2006, the City Council referred a series of charter amendments to the voters of the City of Portland to reform the FPDR system. The charter amendments called for the appointment of a five-person FPDR Board of Trustees. The five-person Board is to consist of the Mayor or the Mayor's designee approved by the City Council; one Active Member serving in the Bureau of Fire; one Active Member serving in the Bureau of Police; and two citizens of the City of Portland. Section 5-201 of the Charter provides that the Mayor may appoint a designee who shall act as Chairperson of the FPDR Board of Trustees.
