## ORDINANCE No.

\*Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$64,000 and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro for funding to support waste reduction efforts at Community Collection Events in the City (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. BPS partners with Metro to assist Portland Community Collection Events in the form of grant agreements with six Neighborhood District Coalitions, Ordinance 183885, and one Interagency Agreement.
- 2. On January 1, 2017, Metro changed their role, discontinuing the Disposal Voucher Program for Portland Events, but will support the BPS program directly.
- 3. Metro notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the funding to support waste reduction efforts at Community Collection Events in the City of Portland to Bureau of Planning and Sustainability in the amount of \$64,000.
- 4. This is a multi-year grant through 12/31/2018.
- 5. No City match is required.

## NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Metro for the funding to support waste reduction efforts at Community Collection Events in the City of Portland in the amount of \$64,000 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit 1.
- b. The FY 2016/2017 budget is hereby amended as follows:

**GRANTS FUND** 

Fund 217

Business Area - PN

Bureau Program Expenses- \$32,000

c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

d. The Director of Bureau of Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Metro IGA, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
