

ORDINANCE No. 188275

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with TriMet to provide detuning work on the Mt. Scott radio tower and reimbursement to the City in the amount of \$44,132 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

1. TriMet owns the Mt Scott radio tower, located in Happy Valley, Oregon and occupied in part by equipment owned by the City of Portland.
2. Work was required to reinforce the tower to accommodate new equipment on the radio tower by the City of Portland for their radio project.
3. TriMet was under obligation from the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to perform a procedure known as "detuning" the tower for radio propagation purposes.
4. TriMet was unable to perform the work in a timeframe that was acceptable to the City.
5. Both TriMet and the City agreed that the work needed to reinforce the tower should be performed and that the "detuning" of the tower could be performed by the City's contractor.
6. TriMet would reimburse the City for costs associated with this work to a cost of \$44,132.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

- a. Authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) with TriMet in a form substantially in accordance with the IGA in Exhibit A to provide detuning work and reimbursement to the City.
- b. Authorize the City to invoice TriMet for \$44,132 as reimbursement for work done on TriMet's behalf on the Mt. Scott radio tower.
