**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

The purpose of this legislation is to authorize a grant application to Oregon Office of State Fire Marshal (OSFM) for a grant to pay for intermediate and advanced training programs for the PF&R HazMat Team.

- If PF&R receives this grant it will provide much needed training for the PF&R specialty teams primarily responsible for handling hazardous materials transportation accidents and incidents.
- This training supports the City's Emergency Preparedness policies.

**Financial and budgetary impacts:**

- This is a grant application and has no direct financial or budgetary impact. If PF&R receives the award, PF&R's budget will be amended with an appropriation entered for training expenses which will be covered entirely by the grant award.
