

ORDINANCE No. 188281

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for construction of the SW 45th Avenue and Fanno Creek Culvert Replacement Project No. E08676 for an estimated cost of \$735,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to replace an undersized culvert crossing under SW 45th Avenue to reduce the risk of flooding and provide fish passage.
2. The replacement of the culvert crossing will reduce the risk of flooding, enhance fish passage, and provide stream restoration in this reach of Fanno Creek.
3. The estimated cost is \$735,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2017-FY2021, CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element, E08676.C60.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.


