ORDINANCE No. 188286

Amend the Regulation of Lobbying Entities code to correct duplication error and align requirements for lobbying registration (Ordinance; amend Code Chapter 2.12)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On June 29, 2016 Council passed Ordinance No. 187854, which clarified requirements and updated Auditor duties and administration of City Code Chapter 2.12, Regulation of Lobbying Entities.
- 2. Before Ordinance No. 187854 went into effect, a lobbying entity that spent more than 8 hours lobbying in a calendar quarter was required to register and report lobbying activities to the City. Ordinance No. 187854 amended Sections 2.12.030 and 2.12.040 to add a threshold of \$1,000 or more spent lobbying as an additional trigger for registration and reporting.
- 3. Subsection 2.12.050B duplicates the 8-hour threshold in 2.12.030 and 2.12.040 by exempting lobbying entities that do not spend more than 8 hours lobbying from the registration requirements. This section of code should have been deleted or amended in Ordinance No. 187854 to reflect the new dollar threshold established in Sections 2.12.030 and 2.12.040.
- 4. Because Subsection 2.12.050B could be read to undermine the code amendments and policy direction set by Ordinance No. 187854, Section 2.12.050B should be removed for clarity and enforcement purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. Amend City Code Subsections 2.12.050 B. and C.as follows:
- **B.** Lobbying entities that spent fewer than 8 hours lobbying during every calendar quarter in a calendar year.
- $\mathbf{C}\mathbf{\underline{B}}$. remainder unchanged
