

ORDINANCE No. 188289

Authorize CityFleet to purchase replacement Asphalt Grinder for use by Bureau of Transportation at \$695,825.
(Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services replaces all City vehicles based on an annual replacement plan.
2. CityFleet has reviewed the standard replacement schedule and the condition of the Asphalt Grinder machine (Vehicle 037010).
3. It has been determined that Vehicle #037010 meets or exceeds the established criteria and needs to be replaced for the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) – Exhibit A attached.
4. The City now desires to purchase this vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services, OMF, is hereby authorized to purchase this vehicle for use by the Portland Bureau of Transportation per the listed request identified in the attached, Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said purchase from the CityFleet replacement fund.


