

ORDINANCE No. 188295

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for construction of the Richmond - South Tabor Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10383 for \$4,260,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Approximately 12,484 feet of severely deteriorated combined sewer pipe in the Richmond – South Tabor area between, SE Division and SE Powell on the north and south, and by SE 36th and SE 71st Ave. on the west and east, and needs to be replaced or rehabilitated.
2. The Bureau of Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for replacing or rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe, including sewer manholes, inlets and service laterals.
3. The estimated cost is \$4,260,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2017- FY 2021 CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services WBS Element E10383.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council’s acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer’s report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney’s office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
