ORDINANCE No. 188296

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for construction of the Slough Outfall 104b Project No. E10625 for \$2,255,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to retrofit the existing storm drainage system to treat urban stormwater runoff prior to discharging to the Columbia Slough.
- 2. This project, the Slough Outfall 104b, is part of a larger effort to meet a 2005 Record of Decision (ROD) and a 2015 IGA between the City of Portland and Oregon DEQ to control contamination sources of stormwater that drain to the Columbia Slough.
- 3. The project involves constructing 53 green street facilities to treat stormwater, ADA improvements for the local residents, utility relocations and a monitoring program to track the performance of the stormwater facilities.
- 4. The estimated cost is \$2,255,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2017-FY2021 CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services WBS Element E10625.C60

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the a. lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to b. the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
