

**ORDINANCE No. 188296**

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for construction of the Slough Outfall 104b Project No. E10625 for \$2,255,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to retrofit the existing storm drainage system to treat urban stormwater runoff prior to discharging to the Columbia Slough.
2. This project, the Slough Outfall 104b, is part of a larger effort to meet a 2005 Record of Decision (ROD) and a 2015 IGA between the City of Portland and Oregon DEQ to control contamination sources of stormwater that drain to the Columbia Slough.
3. The project involves constructing 53 green street facilities to treat stormwater, ADA improvements for the local residents, utility relocations and a monitoring program to track the performance of the stormwater facilities.
4. The estimated cost is \$2,255,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2017-FY2021 CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services WBS Element E10625.C60

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
