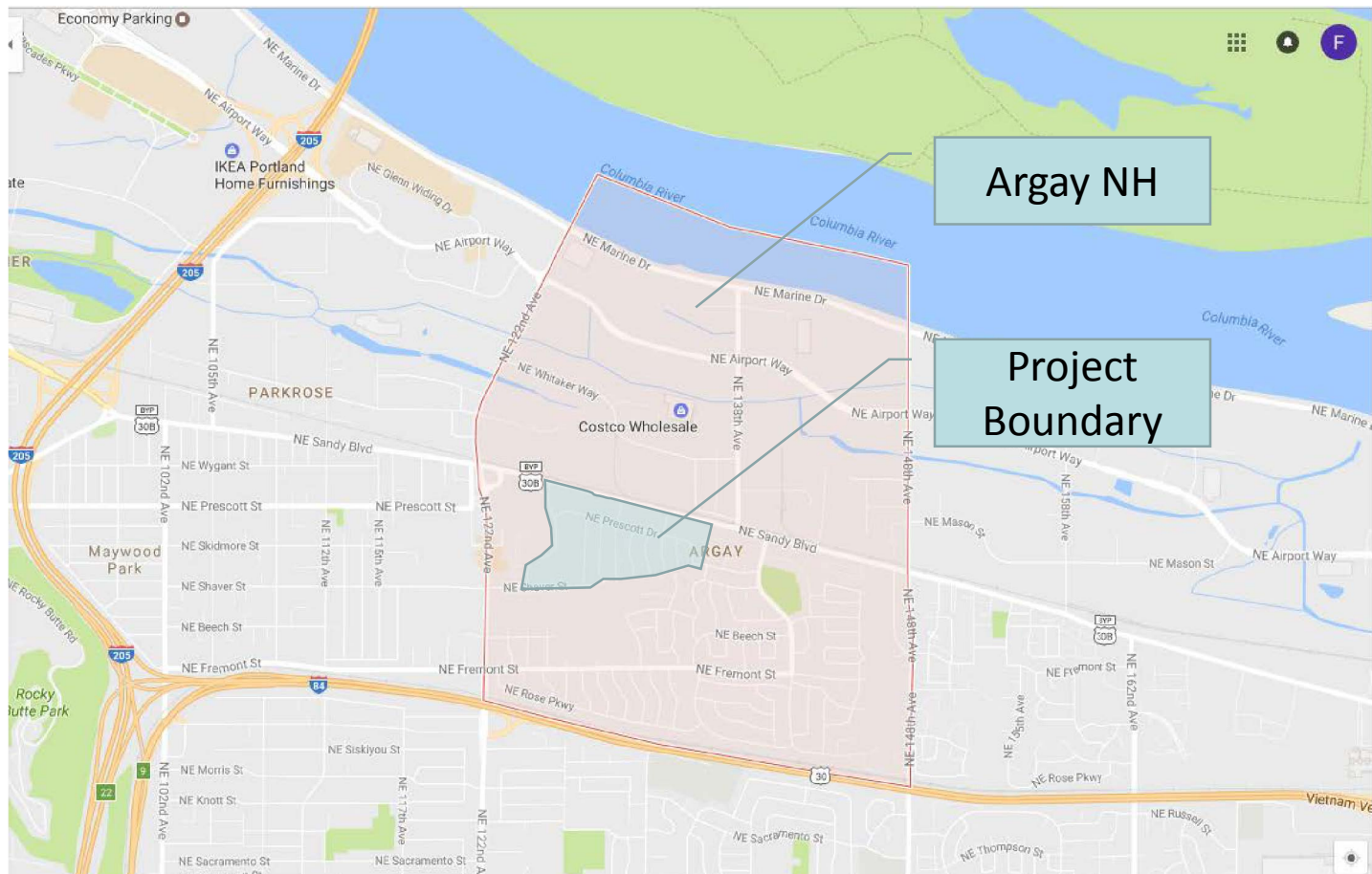

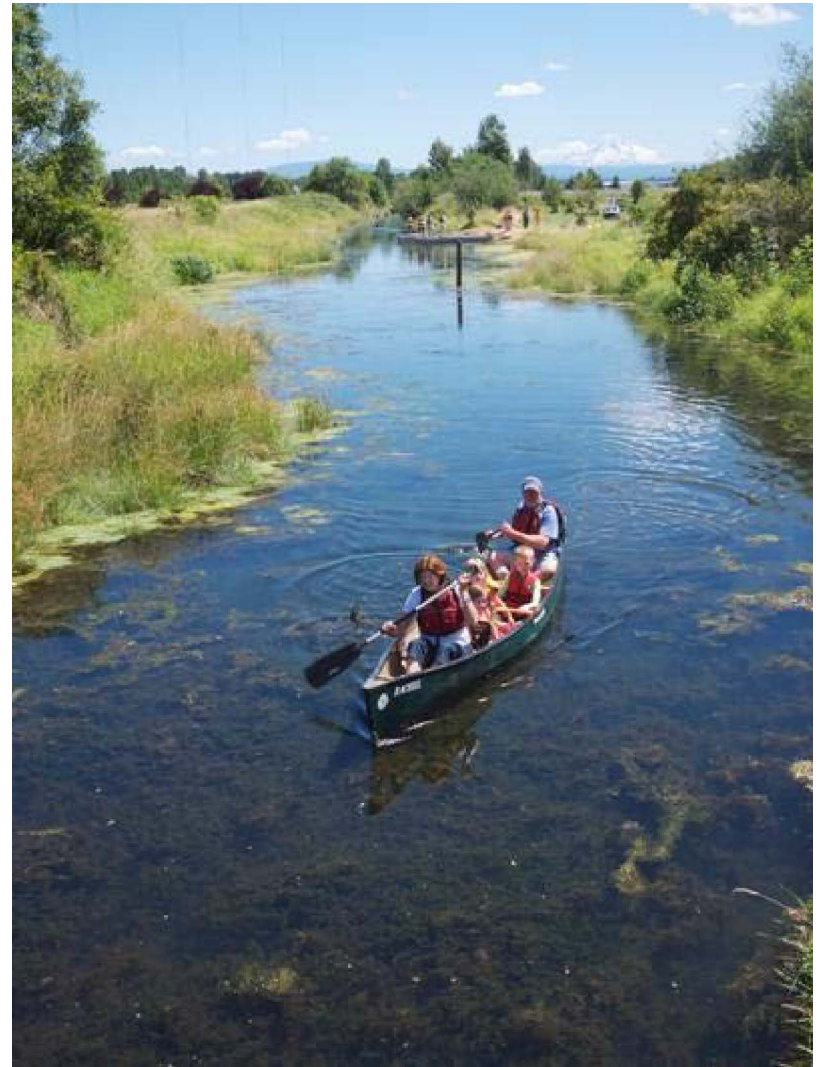

Background

- Record of Decision (ROD), DEQ, 2005
- DEQ Priority Outfall
- One of 71 basins that drain to Slough



Project Goals and Objectives

- Treat runoff from City Right-of-Way
- Comply with the 2005 ROD and the 2010 IGA
- Receive a “no-further action” decision



Project Description

- Construct 53 Green Street curb extension facilities to treat stormwater
- Build 32 ADA ramps, Title II requirements
- Relocation of existing waterlines
