ORDINANCE NO. 188299

* Amend contract with Income Property Management Company for operational expenses of the Joyce Hotel not to exceed \$100,000 for a total value of \$190,000 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30005526)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. The Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) purchased the Joyce Hotel in September, 2016 pursuant City Council authorization in Ordinance 187988.
- 2. PHB purchased the Joyce Hotel intending to renovate and preserve the building for permanent affordable housing in accordance with the Central City No Net Loss policy. Renovations will include seismic upgrades and interior improvements.
- 3. PHB amended an existing contract with Income Property Management (IPM) to provide property management at the time of purchase.
- 4. PHB continues to work with existing residents to identify suitable housing and operations are not entirely covered by rents. PHB and IPM desire to amend the contract to allow for an infusion of funds into the operating account for the remainder of the contract term (to June 30, 2017).
- 5. PHB and IPM anticipate that this amendment will provide sufficient funding for operational expenses as well as IPM's contracted fee of \$2,950 per month for the remainder of the contract term, by which time we expect all residents to have been relocated and renovation began.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs that:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute an amendment to contract number 30005526 with Income Property Management Co. (IPM) to increase the contract value by an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for the purposes identified in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver check(s) payable to the contractor chargeable to the appropriate authorization and accounting center when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with the purchases may result in additional expense; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
