ORDINANCE No. 188306

*Authorize a competitive solicitation for Merchant Services for a 5-year contract period at an estimated total cost of \$25,000,000. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Treasury Division of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services in the Office of Management and Finance (OMF) is responsible for providing merchant services to bureaus and programs that choose to accept credit/debit cards as payment.
- 2. Merchant services refers to the authorization, processing and settlement of credit card and debit card transactions.
- 3. The estimated cost for merchant services over a period of five (5) years is approximately \$25,000,000. The contract will be paid for by bureaus using the service, and paid out of the using bureau's budget.
- 4. OMF seeks Council's authorization for Procurement Services to issue a competitive solicitation for merchant services.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this service is moderate.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer to facilitate the use of a competitive solicitation process in accordance with City Code 5.33 for the procurement of merchant services.
- b. Upon Council acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's Report, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with the selected vendor.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the solicitation will negatively impact all the City bureaus and programs that accept credit/debit cards as payment; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
