

ORDINANCE No. 188309

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of the Beaverton-Hillsdale Hwy – Phase 1 Drainage Retrofits for Water Quality Project No. E08675 for an estimated cost of \$787,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to retrofit the existing storm sewer system along SW Beaverton-Hillsdale Highway to improve water quality.
2. The storm sewer retrofits, including stormwater planters and StormFilter catch basins will remove sediment and pollutants from runoff prior to discharge to Fanno Creek, a TMDL listed waterbody.
3. The estimated cost is \$787,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2017-FY2021, CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element, E08675.C60.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.




