## **ORDINANCE No.** 188309

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of the Beaverton-Hillsdale Hwy – Phase 1 Drainage Retrofits for Water Quality Project No. E08675 for an estimated cost of \$787,000 (Ordinance)

## The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to retrofit the existing storm sewer system along SW Beaverton-Hillsdale Highway to improve water quality.
- 2. The storm sewer retrofits, including stormwater planters and StormFilter catch basins will remove sediment and pollutants from runoff prior to discharge to Fanno Creek, a TMDL listed waterbody.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$787,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2017-FY2021, CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element, E08675.C60.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
