ORDINANCE No. 188317

*Authorize a three-year Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University in the amount of \$187,289 for the Multifamily Waste Reduction Project to implement, evaluate and improve the recycling, garbage and compost system for multifamily communities (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Both the State of Oregon and the City of Portland have adopted aggressive waste reduction goals that rely on increasing recycling for all sectors, residential, multifamily and commercial.
- 2. In June 2015 Council adopted the 2015 Climate Action Plan, establishing the next set of actions to put Portland on track to achieve its previously adopted goal to reduce carbon emissions 80 percent below 1990 levels by 2050 (Resolution 37135).
- 3. As of July 2005, Solid Waste and Recycling Administrative Rules mandate that all recycling and garbage companies collect recyclables from multifamily complexes using a standardized two-sort system.
- 4. Multifamily Waste Reduction Program offers direct assistance and resources to haulers, property owners, managers and residents of multifamily communities to ensure these communities have access to a high functioning waste collection system.
- 5. Portland State University staff provide in the field direct assistance to over 18,000 multifamily units annually, delivering essential assistance, resources and recommendations for improvement.
- 6. The established cost is \$187,289 for three years. Funds are available in the Solid Waste Management Fund, FY 16/17 Adopted Budget, Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, Cost Center PNSD000004, Cost Object 9PNSWC000003. Funding for FY 17/18 and FY 18/19 will be appropriated in FY 17/18 and FY 18/19.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental grant agreement with Portland State University attached as Exhibit 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for this grant chargeable to the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, Cost Object 9PNSWC000003.
- c. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is hereby authorized to sign amendments for continuing data management, reporting and funding in future fiscal years if appropriations are approved by City Council.
- d. The City Council waives the competitive application process required in FIN 2.04 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to forward funds for services to continue work that benefits the City. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
