ORDINANCE No. 188326

* Authorize a Grant Agreement to accept \$25,000 from Drive Oregon Foundation to support Low Cost Air Quality Sensor work, an air quality sensor project in the Powell-Division corridor (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Drive Oregon Foundation notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant to support the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability's Low Cost Air Quality Sensor Program in the amount of \$25,000;
- 2. The Drive Oregon Foundation grant will be used to support and further efforts underway via the National Institute of Standards and Technology's Replicable Smart City Technologies Cooperative Agreement Program grant in the amount of \$100,000, Ordinance 187957.
- 3. No match is required.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Drive Oregon Foundation for the support of an air quality sensor project in the Powell-Division corridor in the amount of \$25,000 as attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2016-17 budget is hereby not amended and the full amount will be appropriated in FY 2017-18 through the Fall BuMP.
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

d. The Director of Bureau of Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications of the Drive Oregon Foundation grant for provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
