

## EXHIBIT A

## Grant Agreement

This agreement is between Drive Oregon Foundation "Grantor", a nonprofit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Oregon and having its principal place of business at 1732 NW Quimby St, Suite 240, Portland, OR 97209, and the City of Portland "Grantee", a local government having its principal place of business at 1900 SW 4<sup>th</sup> Ave Suite 7100, Portland, OR 97212.

This agreement covers the period of March 15, 2017 to June 30, 2018, term to be extended upon written mutual agreement.

Drive Oregon agrees to:

- Provide payment of \$25,000, paid within 30 days of the execution of this grant by both parties.

The City of Portland agrees to:

- Evaluate, acquire, test, and calibrate low cost air quality sensors.
- Deploy approximately 10 sensors at key locations including Southeast Powell & 26<sup>th</sup> and Southeast Division & 122<sup>nd</sup> co-located with existing reference monitoring equipment.
- Explore techniques and methodologies of how to use improved real-time pollution data to evaluate the ability of traffic-signal projects to reduce roadside pollutant concentrations; to improve public health and equity assessments; and to strengthen Portland's Climate Action Plan.
- Develop community engagement strategies for identifying final sensor locations and communicating short-term pollution measurement data
- Produce a final report documenting findings to help other cities implement similar low cost urban air pollution monitoring efforts
