SUBJECT: The Intertwine Alliance Summit

From April 25 through April 27, Portland will host international and local urbanists for a summit to share regional and international examples of green city building across multiple disciplines and for discussions about convening a 2018 international symposium on *The Nature of Cities*.

This small workshop of international and local urbanists is being convened by *The Intertwine Alliance*, *The Nature of Cities*, the *Urban Greenspaces Institute*, Portland State University's *Institute for Sustainable Solutions* and *Indigenous Nations Studies Program*, *The Nature Conservancy*, and the *Bullitt Foundation*.

The April 26 summit is hosted by *The Intertwine Alliance* and will feature presentations and roundtable discussions among international and local experts and stakeholders. Core themes will include trans-disciplinarity, the multiple roles of nature in the city, green infrastructure and urban design, adapting to climate change, art, equity, and inclusion.
