

ORDINANCE No. 188346

* Accept and appropriate an additional \$30,000 from the Oregon Department of Transportation Traffic Safety Division FY 2017 Speed Enforcement Grant program for sworn personnel overtime reimbursement (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Safety Division (TSD) has notified the City that it will provide additional funding for the FY 2017 Speed Enforcement Grant program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$30,000;
2. The Portland Police Bureau accepted a grant in the amount of \$15,000 from ODOT for the FY 2017 Speed Enforcement Grant program in December 2016 with the passing of Ordinance 188144;
3. With the additional \$30,000, ODOT will now reimburse the City a maximum of \$45,000 for sworn personnel overtime worked on speed enforcement at top speed-involved crash locations in Portland as determined by ODOT TSD data during the grant period. A second priority of these enforcement patrols may be texting and cell phone use while driving;
4. ODOT reimburses officer overtime at a rate of \$63.99 per hour and sergeant overtime at a rate of \$70.75 per hour;
5. An additional \$7,500 of local match is required by matching straight-time enforcement hours, which will be funded by existing bureau General Fund appropriation;
6. The total local match for the grant period will now be \$11,250;
7. The grant period is October 1, 2016, through September 30, 2017; and
8. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOT TSD.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to ODOT TSD in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A for a grant in the amount of \$30,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.

- c. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City a grant from ODOT TSD for the FY 2017 Speed Enforcement Grant program in the amount of \$30,000.
- d. The FY 2016-17 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund - 217

Business Area - PL


Bureau Program Expenses - \$30,000

- e. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- f. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City any subsequent modifications by ODOT TSD FY 2017 Speed Enforcement Grant program, SC-17-35-11 PPB, provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOT TSD. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
