

ORDINANCE No. 188359

* Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County, Oregon for the use of U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance National Sexual Assault Kit Initiative Program grant funds of \$98,160 for agency personnel expenses (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) awarded supplemental grant funding to the City under the Federal Fiscal Year 2016 (FFY 2016) National Sexual Assault Kit Initiative (SAKI) Solicited – Strategic Initiatives;
2. The Federal SAKI Program addresses the issue of unsubmitted sexual assault kits at the Portland Police Bureau;
3. A condition of the grant program requires the City to serve as fiscal agent for subgrantees. The City wishes to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Multnomah County Office of the District Attorney (MCDA) to obligate agency roles and responsibilities as related to the FFY 2016 SAKI Program;
4. The City will, with DOJ OJP BJA grant funds, reimburse MCDA for all approved program expenses not to exceed \$98,160;
5. The Agreement shall begin February 14, 2017, and extend through March 31, 2020, or until grant funds are exhausted; and
6. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the grant program work approved by DOJ.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement in a form similar to the Agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the Grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

- c. The Chief of the Police or the Grant Site Coordinator is authorized to accept on behalf of the City any subsequent modifications to this Agreement provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by Council.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the grant program work approved by DOJ. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
