Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This Ordinance reestablishes the 2017-18 City of Portland Employee Benefits Program. The updated Document identifies the provisions of the Cafeteria Plan and the City's self-insured and insured benefit program offerings. The Plan is designed to permit an Eligible Employee to elect various Benefits and to pay for those Benefits with a combination of Employer Contributions and Employee Contributions. Employee Contributions may be paid on a pretax salary reduction basis under the Premium Payment Plan or with after-tax deductions, as permitted under the applicable federal Codes. This document does not change specific policy regarding the Benefit Program

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The Health Funds and Payroll Clearing Funds includes the appropriation in support of the costs associated with the City of Portland Employee Benefit Program. All expected costs are budgeted as part of existing contracts with program vendors.
