The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. In accordance with the Ordinance Number 188052, a portion of the U.S. Housing and Urban Development HOME grant is attributable to Gresham's participation in the Consortium, and Gresham is entitled to plan for the expenditure of such funds.
- 2. Gresham received an additional \$8,000 in earned program income which will increase the total program resources for the agreement to \$936,067.
- 3. Funds for this agreement are available in the approved FY 2016-17 Budget for HOME funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an amended agreement with City of Gresham for the City of Gresham's HOME Investment Partnership Program in a form substantially in accordance with the amendment attached as Exhibit A

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the program funds must be obligated within required timeframes; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
