

ORDINANCE NO. 188361

* Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Gresham to add \$8,000 for new total of \$936,067 from the HOME Investment Partnership Program (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30005339)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

1. In accordance with the Ordinance Number 188052, a portion of the U.S. Housing and Urban Development HOME grant is attributable to Gresham's participation in the Consortium, and Gresham is entitled to plan for the expenditure of such funds.
2. Gresham received an additional \$8,000 in earned program income which will increase the total program resources for the agreement to \$936,067.
3. Funds for this agreement are available in the approved FY 2016-17 Budget for HOME funds.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an amended agreement with City of Gresham for the City of Gresham's HOME Investment Partnership Program in a form substantially in accordance with the amendment attached as Exhibit A

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the program funds must be obligated within required timeframes; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


