# **ORDINANCE No.** 188363

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the construction of the NW Industrial St and 28<sup>th</sup> Ave Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10782 for an estimated \$2,000,000 (Ordinance)

### The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to replace approximately 582 feet of 15" and 18" combined sewer on NW Industrial St. between NW 26<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> Ave. because they are in failing condition.
- 2. Plans and specifications have been prepared by BES for replacing the failing sewer system including sewer pipes, manholes, service laterals, inlets and inlet pipes.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$2,000,000. The level of confidence is high due to highly variable ground condition including groundwater and undocumented fill material. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2018- FY 2019 CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10782.C60.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
