

ORDINANCE No. 188363

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the construction of the NW Industrial St and 28th Ave Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10782 for an estimated \$2,000,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to replace approximately 582 feet of 15" and 18" combined sewer on NW Industrial St. between NW 26th and 28th Ave. because they are in failing condition.
2. Plans and specifications have been prepared by BES for replacing the failing sewer system including sewer pipes, manholes, service laterals, inlets and inlet pipes.
3. The estimated cost is \$2,000,000. The level of confidence is high due to highly variable ground condition including groundwater and undocumented fill material. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2018- FY 2019 CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10782.C60.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.



