

## ORDINANCE No. 188364

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder for construction of the Slabtown Sewer Replacement Project No. E10663 for an estimated cost of \$8.86 million (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has identified in their 2012 Systems Plan a need to replace undersized and structurally deficient sewers in the Fremont & Tanner B Basins. Approximately 6,930 linear feet of combined and storm sewer mainline pipe will be replaced by this project with pipe with adequate capacity (8-42 inches in diameter), and about 1,440 linear feet of new combined sewer pipe will be installed (14-16 inches in diameter) via trenchless pipe bursting method. Also, approximately 2,450 linear feet of six-inch sewer service laterals will be replaced from the sewer to curb with this project.
2. The Bureau of Environmental Services, along with ABHT Structural Engineers, has prepared plans and specifications for the Slabtown Sewer Replacement Project. The Bureau of Environmental Services requires the furnishing of materials and labor for this project.
3. The estimated cost is \$8,860,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2018-FY2019, CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element, E10663.C60.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.


