Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder for construction of the Tabor-Powell Sewer Rehabilitation Phase II Project No. E10382 for an estimated \$1,875,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Approximately 14,313 feet of combined sewer pipe will be rehabilitated using UV cure-in-place lining, and 431 feet of failing sewer pipe will be replaced by open cut construction method.
- 2. The Bureau of Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for replacing or rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$1,875,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2018-19 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services WBS Element E10382.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget
