

**ORDINANCE No. 188375**

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder for construction of the Tabor-Powell Sewer Rehabilitation Phase II Project No. E10382 for an estimated \$1,875,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Approximately 14,313 feet of combined sewer pipe will be rehabilitated using UV cure-in-place lining, and 431 feet of failing sewer pipe will be replaced by open cut construction method.
2. The Bureau of Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for replacing or rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe.
3. The estimated cost is \$1,875,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2018-19 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services WBS Element E10382.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget
