# ORDINANCE No. 188381

\*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation to define the roles and responsibilities for real property to be obtained and used as part of right-of-way for road, street or construction of public improvements for the St Johns Truck Strategy Phase II Project (Ordinance)

### The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- In May of 2011, Council adopted the recommendations of the St Johns Truck Strategy to reduce conflicts between freight mobility and neighborhood livability within the St Johns Town Center.
- 2. In 2012 the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) to applied for federal funding through the Regional Flexible Funds Program administered by Metro and was awarded \$3,002,356 to design and construct Phase II of the St Johns Truck Strategy.
- On March 16<sup>th</sup> of 2016, Council adopted Ordinance #187653 that accepted the Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation that allows PBOT to use the grant funding for design and construction of the St Johns Truck Strategy Phase II Project.
- 4. This Agreement clarifies PBOT's obligations for acquiring the right-of-way necessary to construct the project with federal funds.
- The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is low. The
  cost estimate for the design and construction will be developed during the design
  phase.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and the Auditor are authorized to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation, substantially in accordance with the agreement attached to the original of this ordinance and, by reference, made a part hereof.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
