

**ORDINANCE NO. 188385**

Accept a donation from the Friends of Portland Fire & Rescue Foundation in the amount of \$594.37 for the Portland Fire & Rescue marine program. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Friends of Portland Fire & Rescue Foundation, a non-profit organization created in 1982, is dedicated to preserving the history of Portland Fire & Rescue and supporting safety education and emergency response training in the Portland metropolitan area.
2. Over the course of its 35-year history, the Friends of Portland Fire & Rescue Foundation have raised funds to support numerous special projects including the Belmont Learning Center at the Historic Belmont Firehouse.
3. The Friends of Portland Fire & Rescue Foundation has raised \$594.37 for the purchase of a fire bell and additional equipment for one of PF&R's new fireboats.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The City Council gratefully accepts the donation of \$594.37 from the Friends of Portland Fire & Rescue and recognizes their service to the City of Portland and their continuous support of Portland Fire & Rescue.


