## **ORDINANCE** No. 188388

\*Pay claim of Jesse Deanda in the sum of \$10,509 involving the Bureau of Transportation. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Jesse Deanda and his automobile insurer, Progressive Insurance, have filed a property damage claim against the City for damages suffered in a motor vehicle accident that occurred on December 16, 2015, involving the Bureau of Transportation.
- 2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$10,509.47, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney. \$1,000 of that amount has previously been advanced by Risk Management to Jesse Deanda, and the balance of \$9,509.47 is payable to Progressive Insurance.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$9,509.47 made payable to Progressive Insurance. (\$1,000 has previously been advanced to Jesse Deanda).
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
