

**ORDINANCE No. 188406**

\*Amend Price Agreement with Bretthauer Oil Co. to provide for payment to furnish fuel for City of Portland vehicles for \$6,500,000 and extend the term through June 25, 2018 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 31000340)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services furnishes the fuel used by City of Portland vehicles.
2. CityFleet is responsible for managing the fuel contracts for the City of Portland.
3. The current fuel Price Agreement will expire on June 30, 2017.
4. Council directed CityFleet to develop a new solicitation with the intent of garnering more local participation in the solicitation process.
5. To accommodate the time and expenditures necessary to develop the new solicitation and enter into new Price Agreement(s) a one-year time extension is necessary.
6. The necessary funds are available in CityFleet's operating budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to amend this Price Agreement for an additional \$6,500,000.00 and extend time as indicated.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said purchases from City Fleet funds.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this amendment may result in depletion of available fuel inventory and possible purchases of fuel at non-contract prices which will be higher than the City's current contract prices. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
