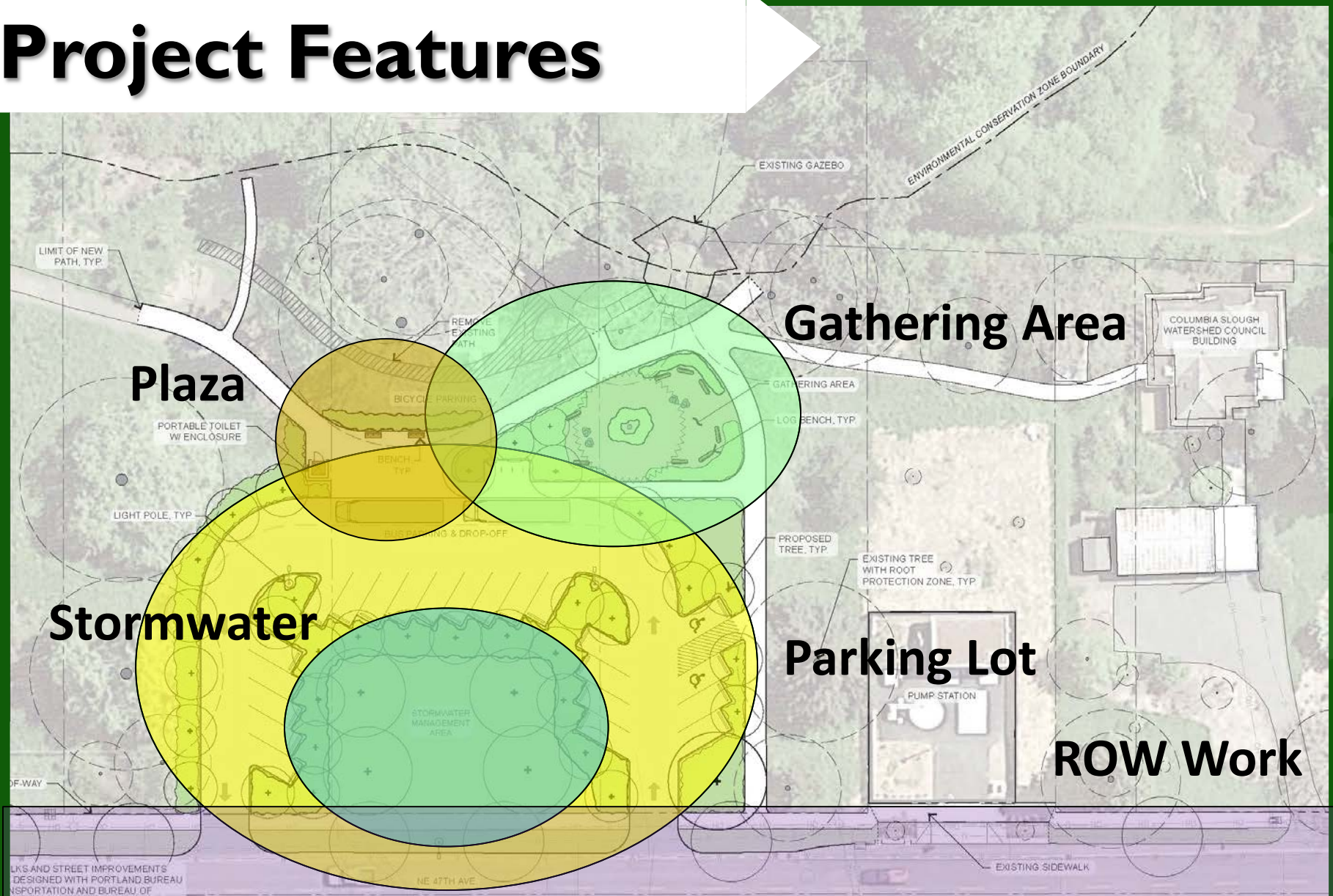
Project Goals

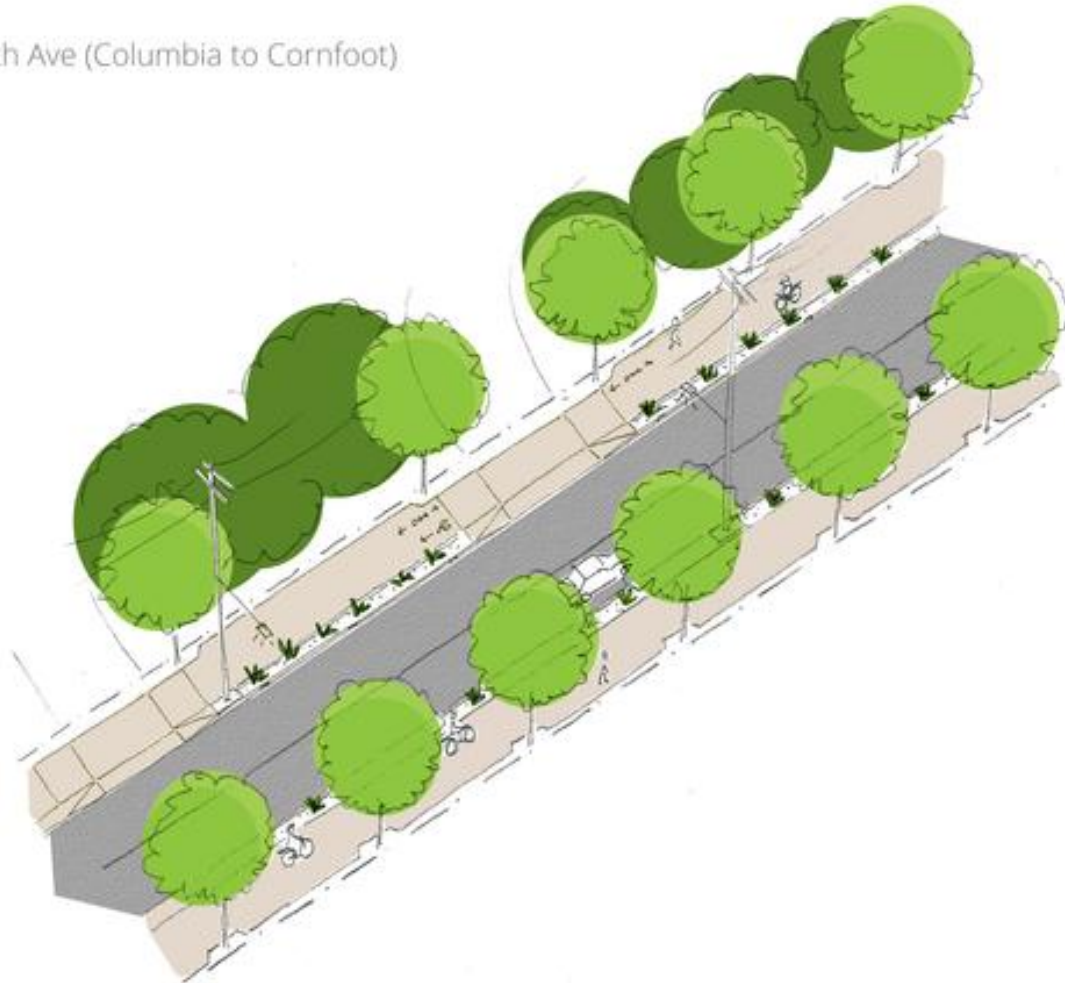
