Map 4 of 4

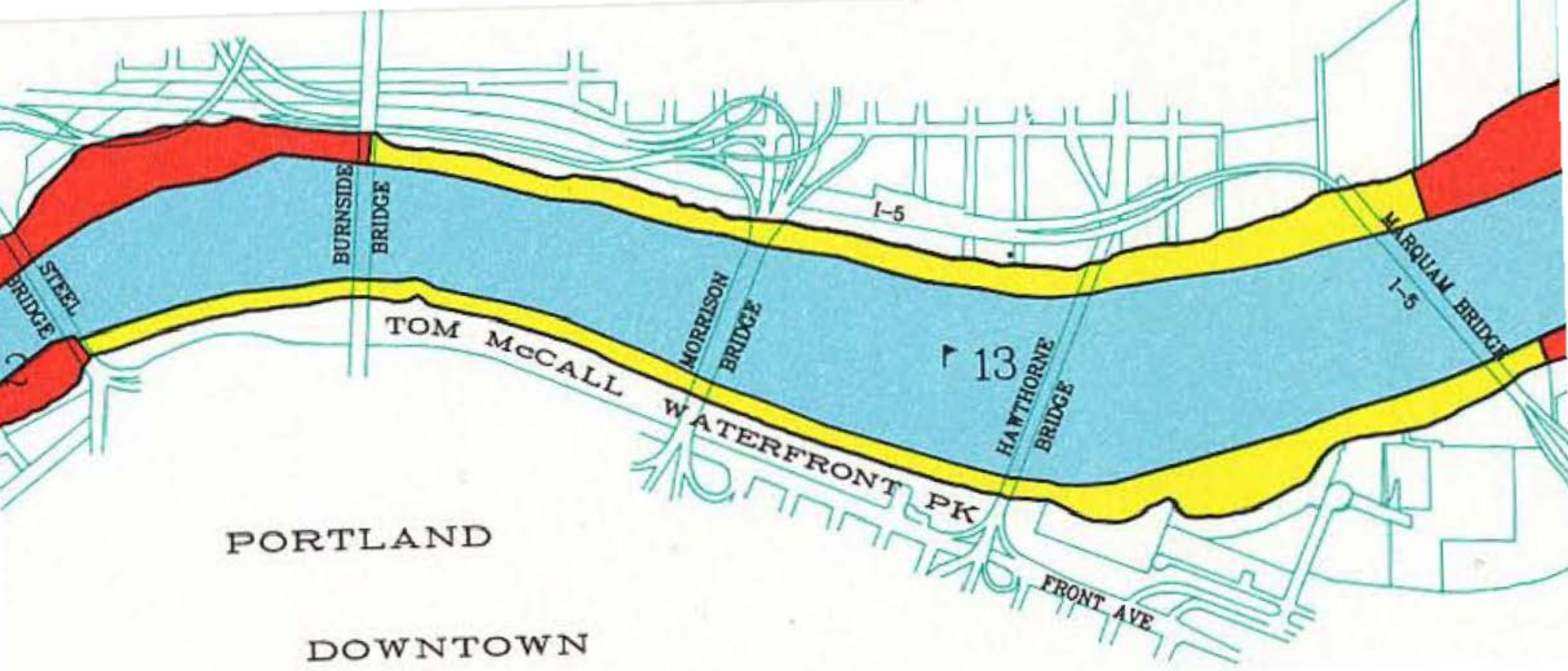

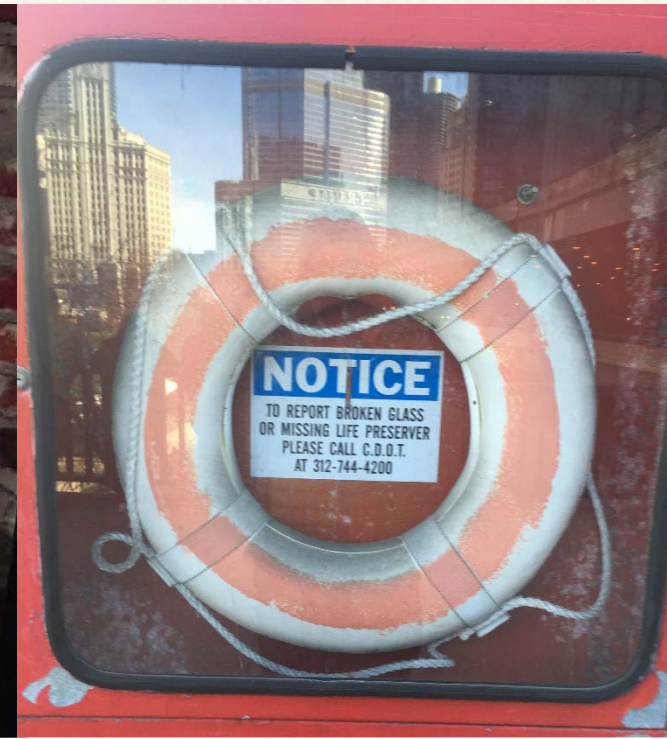
### REDDINGSBOEI

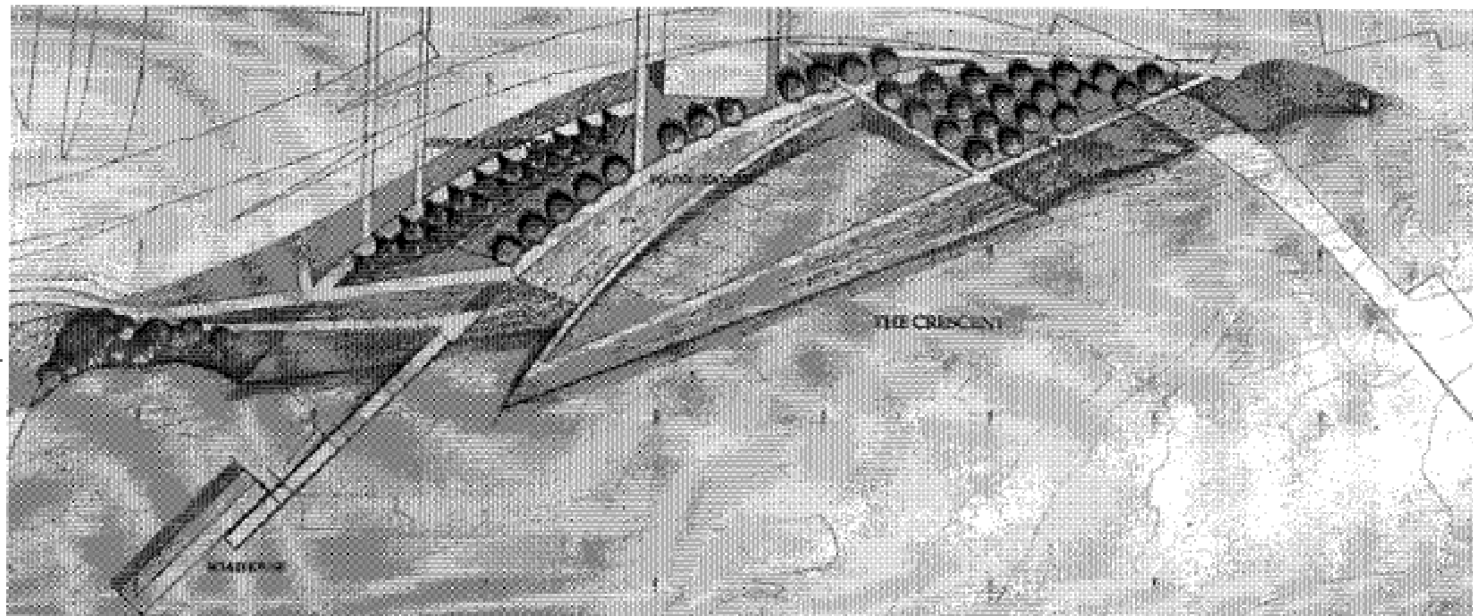
