ORDINANCE NO. 188427

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement to provide the Multnomah County Department of Health Services \$60,339 in FY 2016-17 for efforts related to the enforcement of specified animal regulations in the City (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland, Title 13 Animals states that it shall be the responsibility of the Director of Multnomah County Health Department Vector and Nuisance Control, or the director's designee to enforce the provisions of this chapter; and
- 2. The City agrees to provide financial support to Multnomah County for efforts related to the specified animals; and
- 3. The FY 2016-17 budget includes funding in the General Fund Special Appropriations for the above intergovernmental agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with Multnomah County Department of Health Services in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached as Attachment 1, for the purpose described in Section 1 in the amount up to \$60,339.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority,
- c. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is hereby authorized to sign amendments for continuing data management and reporting.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the IGA. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
