

ORDINANCE No. 188428

*Amend contract with Oregon Department of Transportation for the NE Columbia Blvd at OR 99E/MLK Jr Blvd project (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30005854)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On September 7, 2011, Council approved Ordinance No. 184849 that authorized a grant funding that covered the total anticipated cost for engineering and right-of-way of the project, estimated at approximately \$1,500,286.00.
2. The NE Columbia Boulevard at OR 99E/MLK Jr. Blvd project will construct a dedicated westbound right turn lane on NE Columbia Blvd. at the intersection of NE MLK Jr. Blvd. and NE Columbia Blvd. A 12-foot City standard sidewalk adjacent to the proposed right turn lane and a new traffic signal will also be constructed.
3. On November 8th, 2016, Council approved Ordinance No. 188069 that certify the City of Portland Bureau of Transportation to bid and construct this project as a certification project using federal funds.
4. This amendment will update the milestones so construction funds can be obligated this fiscal year.
5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate. We are at 95% design and are developing the final estimate.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute an amendment, approved as to form by the city Attorney, with Oregon Department of Transportation for the NE Columbia Blvd at MLK Jr Blvd project, in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
