ORDINANCE No. 188433

*Pay claim of Allison Renander in the sum of \$88,376 involving the Portland Police Bureau. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Allison Renander has filed an uninsured motorist claim against the City for damages suffered in a motor vehicle accident that occurred on February 27, 2015, involving the Portland Police Bureau.
- 2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
- 3. Risk Management recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$88,375.86, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney. \$75,000 will be payable to Allison Renander and her attorney, and the balance of \$13,375.86 will be payable to the City's Fire & Police Disability & Retirement Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check for \$75,000 payable to The Law Office of Josh Lamborn (FBO: Allison Renander).
- b. Risk Management is hereby authorized to pay \$13,375.86 from its Insurance & Claims Fund to the Fire & Police Disability & Retirement Fund via an accounting entry to the City's financial system.
- c. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
