ORDINANCE No. 188436

*Authorize grant agreements not to exceed \$28,000 with Albertina Kerr Centers and Different Spokes to acquire bicycles and operate an Adaptive Bicycle Rental Pilot Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland's Climate Action Plan and Transportation System Plan affirm that 25% of all trips in Portland will be made by bicycle by 2035;
- 2. The City's BIKETOWN bike share program has logged over 200,000 trips since launching in July 2016, with 26% of trips by locals replacing automobile trips;
- 3. Prior to launch, the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) received requests for accommodation with BIKETOWN;
- 4. PBOT has undertaken a public outreach process to develop a pilot project;
- 5. PBOT has allocated \$30,000 to develop a pilot project to operate during summer 2017
- 6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with Albertina Kerr Centers in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the pilot project will only occur during the summer months, and to wait an additional 30 days would limit access to the adaptive bicycle pilot and reduced the effectiveness of the pilot); therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
