

ORDINANCE No. 188439 As Amended

*Amend an agreement with the Portland Business Alliance to provide policing services for the Clean and Safe Program (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002749)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Clean & Safe District advocates for public policy decisions that create a clean and safe downtown for everyone who lives, works and visits downtown Portland.
2. The Clean & Safe District encompasses a 213-block area of downtown and is one of the oldest, largest and most successful business improvement districts in the nation.
3. Businesses within Clean & Safe District pay a fee to supplement services for neighborhood improvement, including cleaning, security, community justice services, market research and retail advocacy.
4. The City of Portland and the Portland Business Alliance (PBA) entered into Contract No. 30002749, dated July 1, 2012, to provide Portland Police Bureau (PPB) services to PBA in support of the Clean and Safe Program, costs are reimbursed by PBA in accordance with the terms of the Agreement.
5. The services assist in building and maintaining public confidence in the security and safety of the Clean and Safe District by funding several Portland Police Officer positions that are dedicated to the district service territory.
6. The current contract expires on June 30, 2017.
7. The Police Bureau wishes to extend the current contract for an additional five years.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-charge is authorized to amend Contract No. 30002749 between the City and the Portland Business Alliance as outlined in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Chief of Police and the Project Manager are authorized to execute amendments to the scope of services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the amount of compensation or increase the City's financial risk.
- c. The Police Bureau will give an annual report to City Council on the program.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists due to public safety reasons; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
