Just getting back to confirm dates for the George MS presentation of their 3D map to City Council.

As discussed, we'll get the map to City Hall and set up ahead of the presentation. **The load in date will be Monday June 12th** (we believe PPS will assist with this on that day and if not Monday, then Tuesday, June 13th).
