

Whereas, for ten years, the City of Portland Sunday Parkways presented by Kaiser Permanente has promoted healthy active living through a series of free events opening the city's largest public space -- its streets -- to walk, bike, roll, and discover active transportation fostering civic pride, stimulating economic development, and representing the community, business and government investments in Portland's vitality, livability, and diversity; and

Whereas, Sunday Parkways is about opening streets connecting neighborhoods and people: people on bikes, walking, running, strolling and rolling to enjoy Portland's neighborhoods and family-friendly bicycle/walking routes called Neighborhood Greenways; and

Whereas, Sunday Parkways showcases Portland's wonderful park system and encourages people to play and gather in parks; and

Whereas, the first Sunday Parkways held on June 22, 2008 saw 15,000 participants launching one of the first successful and enduring Open Streets programs across the nation; and

Whereas, the community has embraced Sunday Parkways including 691,815 participants over 39 events, hundreds of community organizations, places of worship, agencies, local, regional and national businesses and vendors, more than 734 individual donors, and dozens of sponsors through its ten-year history;

Now, therefore, I, Ted Wheeler, Mayor of the City of Portland, Oregon, the "City of Roses," do hereby proclaim June 25, 2017 to be
