**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

This Ordinance settles a bodily injury claim brought by Debra Nestlen resulting from a trip and fall accident in a green street facility on January 14, 2016.

**Financial and budgetary impacts:**

This legislation will have no impact on City revenue. This Ordinance does not amend the budget.

Total cost to the City to settle the claim is \$11,678. The payment to be made by this Ordinance is \$11,678 to Debra Nestlen. The source of funding is the City's Insurance and Claims Fund. All cost of the settlement is in the current fiscal year.

**Community impacts and community involvement:**

This Ordinance settles a tort claim resulting from an automobile collision. No public involvement or input was sought regarding this Ordinance. The City Attorney's Office and Risk Management have concluded that it is not appropriate to have public involvement in settlement negotiations regarding tort claims or lawsuits against the City.

No future public involvement is anticipated or necessary. Approval by City Council of this Ordinance will fully settle a tort claim against the City of Portland.
