ORDINANCE No. 188480

*Amend contract with TriMet related to operations and maintenance of the Portland Streetcar system and increase funding to \$7,675,379 (Ordinance; amend Contract No.30002872)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- On July 25, 2012, by Ordinance No. 185526, Council authorized an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with TriMet related to operations and maintenance of the Portland Streetcar system.
- 2. This IGA addresses both the funding provided for Streetcar from TriMet as an integral part of Portland's regional transit system, as well as personnel and other services provided to Streetcar for which TriMet is reimbursed by the City.
- 3. The City and TriMet annually amend this Master Agreement specifically to outline the monthly payments from TriMet to the City for Streetcar operations.
- 4. For FY 17/18, funding from TriMet will be \$7,675,379 based upon an 85% funding share for the NS Line, a 50% funding share for the A and B Loops, and TriMet fare revenue applicable to Streetcar.
- 5. Additionally, Amendment No. 7 provides that beginning in FY 18/19, the methodology for calculating the TriMet annual operating funding share shall be based on net operating cost per vehicle hour, a performance based metric.
- 6. Additionally, Amendment No. 7 leaves unchanged the budget authority provided in Amendment No. 5 for the City to reimburse TriMet for personnel and other services provided to Streetcar estimated to be \$40,490,618 through FY 19/20.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute Amendment No. 7 with TriMet related to the operations and maintenance of the Portland Streetcar system, in a form similar to the contract amendment attached as Exhibit A, as approved by the City Attorney.
- b. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute future Amendments with TriMet related to operations and maintenance of the Portland Streetcar system under Contract No. 30002872, as approved by the City Attorney.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in execution could delay receipt of operations funding from TriMet; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
