Authorize the City Attorney to appear as amicus curiae supporting gender equality on behalf of City of Portland. (Resolution).

WHEREAS, It is the policy of the City of Portland to eliminate discrimination based on gender identity because such discrimination poses a threat to the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Portland and menaces the institutions and foundation of our community. (See PCC 23.01.010);

WHEREAS, In *Dee Fulcher, et al., v. Secretary of Veterans Affairs.,* an important civil rights case currently pending before the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, the Court will decide whether the refusal of the Department of Veterans Affairs to cover gender-confirmation surgery violates the United States Constitution's guarantees of Due Process and Equal Protection of the Laws;

WHEREAS, Lambda Legal has recruited City attorneys in Seattle and other major United States cities to join in an amicus brief speaking on behalf of cities nationwide that provide anti-discrimination protections based on gender identity;

WHEREAS, The City amicus brief will focus on the importance of those protections and will demonstrate their administrability;

WHEREAS, The brief is due June 28, 2017;

WHEREAS, The City Attorney will have an opportunity to review the briefs before joining as an official signatory.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Portland, that the City Attorney or her designee, on behalf of the Mayor, the Council, and the City of Portland, may file or join amicus briefs in support of equal treatment for transgender veterans, in the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, and on any further appeal or proceeding, in *Dee Fulcher, et al., v. Secretary of Veterans Affairs,* No. 2017-1460.
